REGISTRATION & POLICY INFORMATION

1. Residents may register immediately in person, by mail or FAX. FAX registrations must include Master Card or VISA number, expiration date and signature. Receipts will be sent by mail or email as soon as the registrations are processed (excluding Ice Skating registrations). **Registration forms can be found on pages 5 and 7.**

2. On-Line Registration: You may register on-line for most programs. Go to www.westhartfordct.gov/leisureservices and click on the On-line Registration button.

3. Nonresident registrations will be accepted in person, by mail, FAX or online. Leisure Services reserves the right to limit non-resident registrations as deemed necessary.

4. If the session you wish to register for is filled, you will be placed on a waiting list and notified when an opening occurs.

5. Children must be the proper age before the program(s) begin.

6. Only those enrolled in the programs may attend. Sorry, but "visitors/family" will not be permitted in the classrooms.

7. Sometimes a class must be cancelled because of lack of enrollment. Please register early to avoid disappointment .

SPECIAL NEEDS PARTICIPATION

Our staff recognizes the value of including people with varying levels of ability and welcomes participation in all programming. This conversation must take place at least **two weeks** in advance of the class start date.

INCLEMENT WEATHER CANCELLATION POLICY

For up-to-date weather cancellation information call the Leisure Line at 860-561-7509. In most cases, if the West Hartford schools are closed, daytime classes may be cancelled. Cancellation of evening programs is decided by 3:00 pm. If in doubt call the facility running the program.

REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

Please sign up early to avoid classes being cancelled due to low enrollment.

- Refunds will be automatic if a session is cancelled.
- Cancellations and refund requests must be made (3) business days before the program begins.
- All refund requests must be made in writing.
- Refunds **will not** be given after a program has begun.
- A 10% processing fee will be deducted from all refunds (minimum \$5.00).
- In case of injury, a written refund request must be accompanied by a doctor's note.
- No refunds will be given on trips, special events, season tickets, and/or passes.

Leisure Services programs follow the West Hartford public school schedule. If changes to the public school schedule affect scheduling of the Leisure Services programs, schedule and pricing adjustments will be made accordingly.

iCan Bike (formerly Lose the Training Wheels)

West Hartford Human & Leisure Services, the Miracle League of West Hartford, Bike West Hartford, and West Hartford Bicycle Advisory Committee have joined forces to continue to bring this innovative program to West Hartford to benefit children ages 8 and above with special needs. iCan Bike uses specially designed, ultra-stable bicycles called “adapted roller training bikes” that enable children who have been previously unable to ride a bicycle to progress to conventional bicycles and become successful riders. The program is staffed by qualified volunteers and professional Town of West Hartford staff under the direction of iCan Bike staff.

Campers register for one session (1 hour 15 minutes) between 8:00 am and 3:45 pm and attend the program at that same time slot for five consecutive days, Monday through Friday. Space is limited to 8 campers per session and time preferences may be listed on the application. The program runs Monday, July 27 through Friday, July 31 at Conard High School, 110 Beechwood Road, West Hartford, CT. Campers start the program in the gym and progress outside as they become more confident riders.

The Special Needs Program is pleased to offer two different half-day camp options for summer 2015. The *Beachland Adventures* camp provides a personalized experience for children requiring greater assistance and/or the services of a nurse. *Escapades at Elmwood* camp offers a much lower staff to camper ratio than a standard town camp but provides many of the same experiences. Families may also consider inclusive recreation at the mainstream camps listed in this brochure if children are capable of participation in an inclusive setting with general assistance provided by the Special Needs Program staff.

Online registration is not available for *Beachland Adventures and Escapades at Elmwood*. Please contact the Special Needs Coordinator (860-561-8173 or victoria.branning@westhartfordct.gov) to discuss camp placement and registration. Those interested in inclusion assistance should ideally contact the Special Needs Coordinator first to discuss options but online registration is available to secure a spot. Conversations with parents and school personnel are essential to determining how to best meet the child’s recreational needs as well as the appropriateness of placements.

Registration will open on Monday, March 9 at 9:00 am at the Elmwood Community Center main office. Packets with required forms and additional camp information will be given (or mailed) to families **after** they have registered. For *Beachland Adventures*, an updated/current physical is required and “Authorization for the Administration of Medicine” form must be completed if your child requires medication during the camp day. Medication is allowed at other camps but staff must be informed before camp begins and the medication must be self-administered.

To receive support through the Special Needs Program, conversations with the Special Needs Coordinator, camp registration and payment MUST be completed by Monday, June 8. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS. This allows adequate time for staff hiring and training and the finalization of daily camp plans. **All medical forms must be completed and returned to the Elmwood Community Center main office by Friday, June 12 for review by the camp nurse. Children will not be allowed to participate in camp if the forms have not been received and reviewed.** No refunds will be given.



