MINUTES TOWN OF WEST HARTFORD COMMISSION ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS Virtual Meeting Thursday, March 18, 7:00 PM

1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER, 7:05 PM

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Hamilton mentioned the "Humans of New York" photo blog and its many spinoffs that focus on people's personal stories. She said that reaching out to veterans and asking them to share their stories could be an effective way of creating greater awareness of their service and sacrifice. She suggested the Commission start with members of the VFW and American Legion, as they would be natural partners for a project like this. Mr. Cortes and Mr. Johnson expressed their enthusiasm for this and volunteered to assist.

Mr. Sheehan wondered if there are any Connecticut residents in units currently deployed and, if so, whether the Commission could connect with them to share their stories. Or perhaps the Commission could "adopt" a unit. There would be many logistics to work out.

Mr. Raider mentioned former Commission member John Rixon and his wife as another possible source to help identify veterans in West Hartford who might be willing to share their stories.
