

TOWN OF WEST HARTFORD ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 2021 MINUTES

The Zoning Board of Appeals held a virtual public hearing on Wednesday, December 15, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., to hear and act on the following petitions:

#14-21 301 North Main Street- Petition of Dr. Frank Aieta (R.O.) requesting a renewal to the Special Exception in order to maintain a customary home occupation (Physician's Office) as an accessory use to the residence per Section 177-49 (C) for a period of five (5) years per plans on file. R-13 zone

At the virtual meeting of the Zoning Board of Appeals, immediately following the public hearing, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Doyle made a motion to grant the petition; Second by Commissioner Harris. In reaching its decision, the Board granted the petition with the following conditions:

- 1. This permission is granted for a period of five (5) years. At that time, the applicant will be notified of the requirement to renew this permit. Failure to renew will render this approval void.
- 2. The hours of operation shall be: **Monday thru Friday**: 8:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m.
- 3. The premises shall be maintained in a manner satisfactory to the Zoning Board of Appeals and the Zoning Enforcement Officer.
- 4. Client parking is to be on-site at the property.
- 5. One non-resident employees permitted.
- 6. A one square foot sign is permitted.
