

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
WEST HARTFORD HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION**

The Historic District Commission of the Town of West Hartford shall hold a public hearing for consideration of the following applications:

1. Certificate of Appropriateness, 1637 Boulevard, submitted by homeowner John McIlhoney, for removal of concrete front steps and replacement with wood.
2. Certificate of Appropriateness, 1590 Boulevard, submitted by homeowner Charles Lucas, for six month time extension of COA approved in August 2019, without changes.

The public hearing will be held on October 26, 2020 at 5:00 pm.
