



# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## WATERMAIN & METER PIT INSTALLATION

(Oakwood Ave Area, West Hartford)

Beginning the **week of April 3<sup>rd</sup>**, the Metropolitan District (MDC) and their contractor, VMS Construction Company, will be starting construction to replace existing watermains, services and install meter pits in your neighborhood. Once the new watermain, meter pit and new water service are installed you will be contacted by MDC Staff to schedule a time for the meter to be relocated from inside your home to its new location.

**During the meter relocation process, your water service may be temporarily interrupted for approximately 4-6 hours.** *An MDC Staff member will contact you in advance of the interruption in service.*

The purpose of the meter pit is to provide easier access to the meter and will eliminate the need to enter homes for meter readings or repairs. In cases where the meter pit installation requires a potential disturbance or need to relocate existing landscaping, fixture or structure, MDC Staff will coordinate with the homeowner to determine best course of action for the meter pit location. Temporary efforts, including backfill and patching of sidewalks will be fully restored to the same or better condition once the entire water main project has been completed. Please refer to the photo examples on the reverse side of this notice.

During the project the contractor may temporarily store materials in the "green-belt" portion of the public right of way (between the sidewalk and the road). Please note that only pipe materials may be stored in the greenbelt and the contractor will restore any disturbed areas to pre-existing conditions upon the completion of work. The project is expected to last 6-8 weeks. Work hours are Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 5:00PM.

Schedules are subject to change based on weather or unforeseen construction related activities. All MDC Staff, Contractors and Consultants must be properly identified and present ID upon request.
